

AMAZING SCAVENGER HUNTS HOW TO BE AN EXPLORER OF THE WORLD

1. RANDOM SCAVENGE

- 1) Take a walk in your neighborhood.
- 2)Collect 10 thing you find on your way.
- 3)Document them on a map. Write a story about each item.



2. QUICK SCAVENGE (FOR BREAKS OUTDOOR)

Collect ten things in ten minutes.




3. SOUND SCAVENGE

Using some kind of sound recorder, record ten different sounds you hear in your environment. If you do not have a sound recorder you can make up different symbols for the sounds you hear and mark them on a map or graph.



4. ALPHABET SCAVENGE

You must find and document the whole alphabet while out on a walk. You will need to use a camera for this.



5. PLANT SCAVENGE

Go to a specific outdoor location (your local park, botanical garden or playground)

Collect as many different kinds of wild plants as you can. (Make sure to avoid poison oak and stinging nettles!)

(Note: If it is a place where the flora and fauna are protected, such as a state park, then document with photos).

It may be helpful to use a plant identification guidebook.



6. PLASTIC SCAVENGE

Collect as many pieces of discarded plastic as you can.

Document them separately or as a group.

Create some kind of installation with the pieces.

8. ONE THING SCAVENGE


Choose one object to collect or document. Some ideas: blue things, rubber bands, tickets, stamps, park benches, etc.

10. URBAN FOSSILS SCAVENGE

Go out and document as many urban fossils as you can find. These will be things that have been embedded somehow in concrete sidewalks footprints (animal and human), leaf prints, patterns, coins, names, etc.
